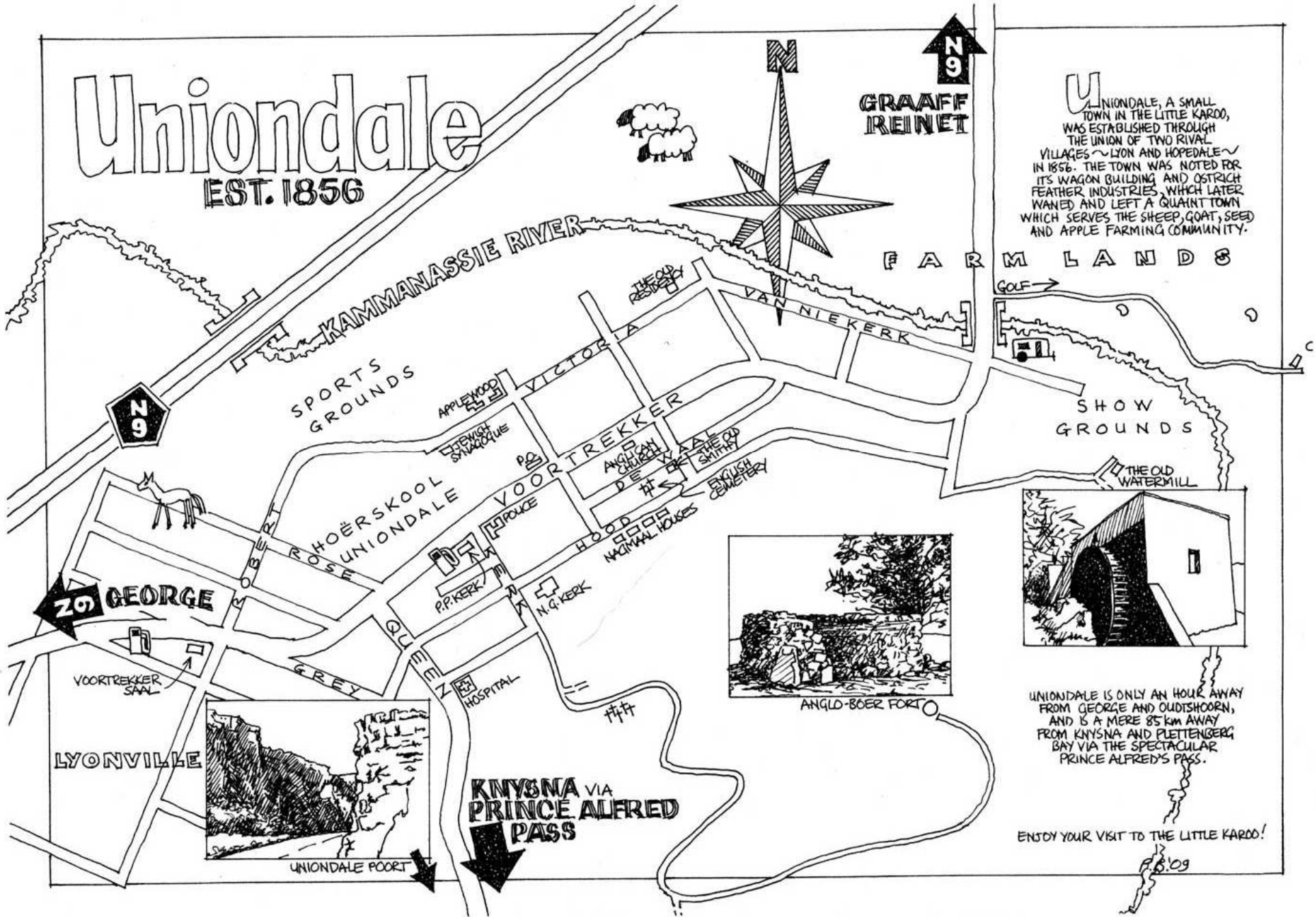


Uniondale

U NIONDALE, A SMALL TOWN IN THE LITTLE KAROO, WAS ESTABLISHED THROUGH THE UNION OF TWO RIVAL VILLAGES ~ LYON AND HOPEDALE ~ IN 1856. THE TOWN WAS NOTED FOR ITS WAGON BUILDING AND OSTRICH FEATHER INDUSTRIES, WHICH LATER WANED AND LEFT A QUAIN TOWN WHICH SERVES THE SHEEP, GOAT, SEED AND APPLE FARMING COMMUNITY.



UNIONDALE IS ONLY AN HOUR AWAY FROM GEORGE AND OUDISHOORN, AND IS A MERE 85 km AWAY FROM KNYSNA AND PLETTENBERG BAY VIA THE SPECTACULAR PRINCE ALFRED'S PASS.
